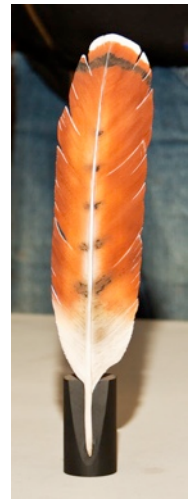

Northern White Cedar

Fred Fox has made contact with a mill in Minnesota for cedar.

3" x 10" \$ 4.50/bd/ft (\$65 includes shipping)

3" x 6" \$ 4.50/bd/ft (\$39 includes shipping)

3" x 8"

All the wood comes in 4 foot lengths, clear with some tight knots and very little wayne.
All kiln dried.

Shipping: under 20 bd/ft - \$2.00 ; over 20 bd/ft - \$1.50/bd/ft

NOW: Any one interested? If we go over 20 bd/ft we knock \$.50/bd/ft off the shipping costs. So for \$40 you get to carve the same wood the old decoys were made of. Call Fred for information at 383 8883 or talk with him at the next meeting. email
