Al Jordan's Bird Carving Class

In February, GVWC continued its 50th anniversary celebration with the second of two classes underwritten by a \$5,000 Arts-in-Education grant awarded to us by Genesee Valley Council on the Arts (GVCA). A total of 16 members worked with acclaimed carvers in the caricature and bird disciplines. Although very different experiences, both events received high marks from all participants. Both groups made requests for more learning opportunities in the future.

Al Jordan is a world-class bird carver who uses power tools exclusively in the creation of his carvings. He taught the three-day class by a combination of lecturing, demonstrating and guiding the students one on one as they transformed their tupelo roughout into a carved, painted and mounted blue jay smoothie. All the participants reported that this intense class increased their skills and knowledge of power carving tools, bird anatomy and paint application.

This project is made possible with funds from the Statewide Community Regrant, a regrant program of the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of the office of the governor and the New York State Legislature and administered by the Genesee Valley Council on the Arts.
